SAVE A SEAT PROGRAM

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

- 1 College freshmen currently enrolled at WSU Pullman, Tri-Cities and Vancouver
- 2 Students with strong academic history in math and science
- 3 Students who have a strong interest and working knowledge of a pharmacy career

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum high school GPA of 3.5
- Enroll at WSU Pullman, Tri-Cities or Vancouver fall semester
- Have less than 30 college level credits accumulated (AP Credits do not count towards this total)
- Complete a Save a Seat application
- Submit two letters of recommendation from teachers, advisors and/or counselors
- Successful completion of interview
- Preference given to Science Technology Engineering Math (STEM) or Project Lead The Way (PLTW) students

MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY

Becoming eligible for the Save A Seat Program is only the first step. There are requirements that you need to be aware of to ensure that you retain the Save A Seat Program throughout your undergraduate career.

- Complete pre-pharmacy courses at WSU Pullman, Tri-Cities or Vancouver in 3 years or receive a Bachelor's degree in 4 years
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA at the end of each pre-pharmacy year
- Earn a "C" or higher in all pre-pharmacy courses
- Apply through "Early Decision" and complete all of the admission requirements of the Doctor of Pharmacy program
- Complete the PCAT (Pharmacy College Admission Test)
- WSU Pre-pharmacy club member (recommended)
